CONVENTION RELATING TO THE STATUS OF REFUGEES

Grounded in Article 14 of the Universal Declaration of human rights 1948, which recognizes the right of persons to seek asylum from persecution in other countries, the United Nations Convention relating to the Status of Refugees, adopted in 1951, is the centrepiece of international refugee protection today. The 1967 Protocol removed limitations and thus gave the Convention universal coverage.
